## Clinical trials are very important in mental health research

They represent the final stage of testing new treatments, like medications or psychotherapies. In these trials, a treatment is often compared to a placebo or different treatment. A participant will usually be "randomized" to receive either the new treatment or a placebo. Because of this randomization, the participant might receive therapeutic benefit, or they might not. However, every clinical trial contributes to advancing scientific knowledge and helping people in the future.

## Before you participate in a clinical trial or scientific study, make sure you can answer the following questions:

- 1. What is the trial/study about?
- 2. What will you be asked to do?
- 3. What risks might you face?
- 4. Has an Institutional Review Board (a group of scientists, doctors, clergy, and patient advocates that review and approve the detailed plan for every clinical trial) approved the study?
- 5. Whom do you contact with questions, concerns, or problems?
- 6. Will you be informed about the progress and results of the study?

Remember that all participation in research is voluntary, and not considered part of your treatment plan.
