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## *Clinical trials are very important in mental health research*

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They represent the final stage of testing new treatments, like medications or psychotherapies. In these trials, a treatment is often compared to a placebo or different treatment. A participant will usually be “randomized” to receive either the new treatment or a placebo. Because of this randomization, the participant might receive therapeutic benefit, or they might not. However, every clinical trial contributes to advancing scientific knowledge and helping people in the future.

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*Before you participate in a clinical trial or scientific study, make sure you can answer the following questions:*

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1. What is the trial/study about?
2. What will you be asked to do?
3. What risks might you face?
4. Has an Institutional Review Board (a group of scientists, doctors, clergy, and patient advocates that review and approve the detailed plan for every clinical trial) approved the study?
5. Whom do you contact with questions, concerns, or problems?
6. Will you be informed about the progress and results of the study?

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*Remember that all participation in research is voluntary, and not considered part of your treatment plan.*
